

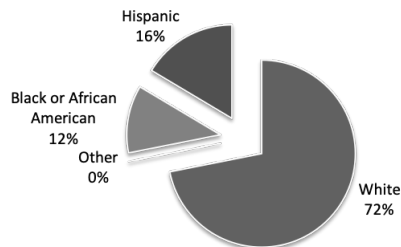

- Every graduate achieves their choice of college and career path

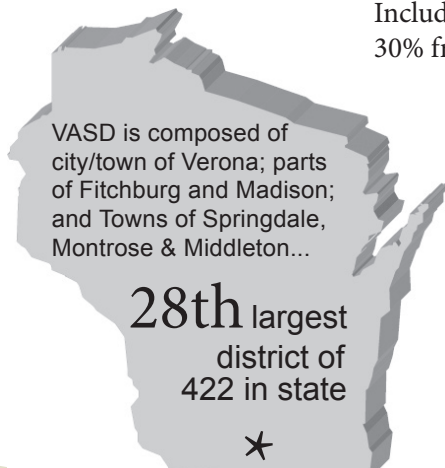
