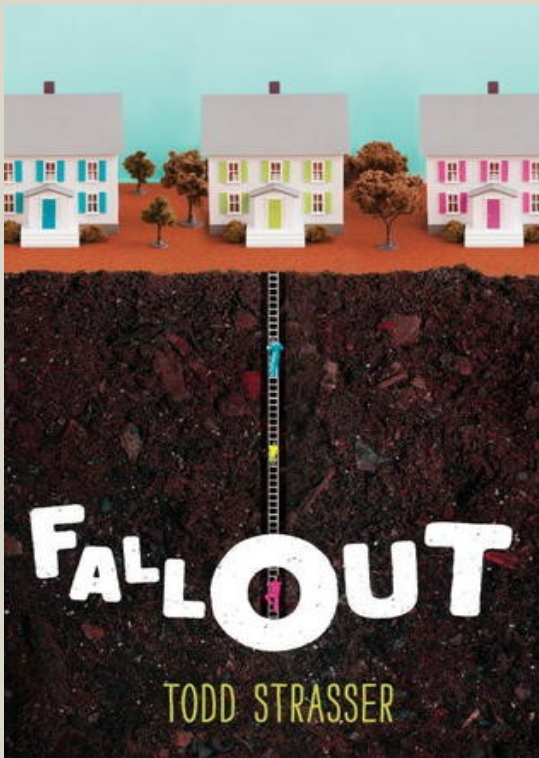


Fitchburg Public Library's Mother-Daughter Book Club

In the summer of 1962, the possibility of nuclear war is all anyone talks about. But Scott's dad is the only one in the neighborhood who actually prepares for the worst. He builds a bomb shelter to hold his family and stocks it with just enough supplies to the family alive for two critical weeks. In late October, when the unthinkable happens, the neighbors force their way into the shelter before Scott's dad can shut the door. With not enough room, food, or air, life inside the shelter is filthy, physically draining, and emotionally fraught. But even worse is the question of what will -- and won't -- remain when the door is opened again.
