- Every graduate achieves their choice of college and career path

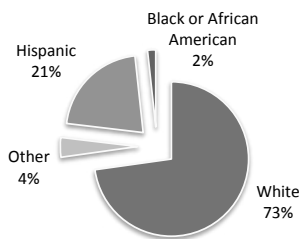

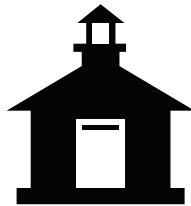

Positive Behavior and Interventions and Supports (PBIS): We were selected as a PBIS School of Merit by the State of Wisconsin in 2013!

Two-Way Immersion Program: This unique program allows 36 new students to choose to join each year, with three goals:

- Achieve a high level of proficiency in understanding, speaking, reading, and writing in both English and Spanish
- Attain academic achievement levels equal or exceeding state standards
- Foster positive cross-cultural attitudes and behaviors throughout the school and community

Verona/Fitchburg Connection: Since 2009 we have held weekly homework club as well as family events several times a year at Nakoma Heights neighborhood to benefit our students and families who live there.

Technology: All classrooms have a SMART Board to provide engaging instruction. We are also 1:1 iPads for all students kindergarten thru fifth grade. We continually offer staff development and support for our teachers incorporating technology into teaching and learning. We are excited to have a makerspace lab with 30 printers for exploration and creation.
