We're excited to break ground and start construction on the new Verona Area High School! The site for the new school is about 150 acres and will include athletic facilities, three ecosystems, a geothermal field, and has the Military Ridge State Trail running through it. The building footprint alone is approximately 7 acres in size! Within the building there will be academics spaces, a fieldhouse, performing arts center and pool. Although the recent weather has been cold and snowy work is already progressing onsite. As the weather warms the pace of construction will ramp up as we progress towards the 2020 completion of the new school!
