Meeting Minutes :

Drew Howick opened the meeting to share working agreements for the group and make introductions, while Kelly Kloepping shared updates on what was available on the website.

Dean Gorrell walked through the Questions/Response document to ensure committee members had questions answered that they shared from the previous meeting. They also clarified some questions that were unclear to be answered for the first round.

Allison Gunderson talked about the current state of student attendance. Maps were shown of current attendance status at our schools.

Updated enrollment projections were shared by Mark Roffers as he shared:

- Impact of housing development and demographic change on student enrollment
- Projection of new housing development through 2030 using community and developer plans
- Applying future student/house ratios to translate housing unit projections into enrollment projections through 2030
- Comparing enrollment projections with current school capacities, identifying buildings and timing of capacity issues
- Applying enrollment projections to different attendance area options, shifting neighborhoods and their projected students

The committee spent some time prepping for the Dec. 5 meeting, so advice was gathered regarding what we would like Mark to consider as he puts together preliminary options for the committee to focus on moving forward.

The committee also discussed the following upcoming conversations that will take place in the next couple meetings and shared additional information they desire to know as agendas are built out:

- Transportation
- Two Way Immersion Program / charter school information
- Open enrollment and boundary exceptions
